CHENIN BLANC 2023

Origin: Greater Cape, South Africa.

Vineyard: Despite the rains that interrupted the harvesting season, the growing season was good, producing grapes of exceptional from various vineyards ranging from young to old, resulting in a complex, textured wine.

Winemaking: The parcels of grapes for this wine were harvested at different times. The grapes were crushed as soon as they arrived in the cellar, after which the juice was pumped into cold temperature-controlled tanks for fermentation. The different wines were matured separately before being blended sensitively together.

Varietal: Chenin Blanc

Analysis: Alc 12.82%

Colour: Pale green

R/ Sugar: 4.5g/l

TA 5.9g/l

pH 3.55

Tasting Notes: This wine is bursting with delicious tropical fruit aromas that follow through to tantalising flavours of yellow apple, green melon and white pear on the palate contributing to a delicious, juicy palate.

Food: Enjoy this wine with light curries, pasta salads or fresh salads and cheese boards.

Ageing Potential: To be enjoyed 1-3 years from the year of vintage.
