A group of black women, all working in the Cape wine industry, realised that they could combine their skillset to create a unique proposition: wine grown, made, marketed and distributed by them and only by them.

They each have a story to tell: Winemaker and General Manager Praisie Dlamini hails from KwaZulu-Natal but studied winemaking in the Cape. She has been working in the wine industry ever since. All of the team have stories of triumph. Each of them, with grit and determination, grabbed the opportunities presented, stepped out of the confinement of their circumstances, and worked their way up in the business world.

ONE OF HER KIND WINES

SHIRAZ 2023

Origin: Western Cape, South Africa.

Vineyard: Moderate weather throughout the season, and specifically during harvest time, resulted in grapes ripening slower. This contributed to good vine growth, bunch numbers and berry sizes with a great flavour profile, creating wines of good colour extraction with low pH levels and high natural acidity, which all point to exceptional quality wine. Grapes for this wine were sourced from several vineyards both young and old which were sensitively vinified and blended to create a complex, vibrant wine.

Winemaking: Grapes for this wine were harvested and destemmed and then 20% of the juice was drained to concentrate the fruit flavours and structure before alcoholic fermentation when timed pump overs were used to further enhance colour and tannin structure. After alcoholic fermentation this wine was pressed, and then a portion of the wine was aged on Hungarian oak for subtle oak influence.

Varietal: Shiraz

Analysis: Alc 13.84%

Colour: Medium purple red

R/ Sugar: 7.1g/l

TA 5.8g/l

pH 3.62

Tasting Notes: Rich dark berry fruit is perfectly balanced by hints of vanilla and spice to create a complex, appealing wine. This is a medium-bodied wine with substance, lingering long on the palate.

Food: A wine to enjoy on its own but will also pair beautifully with a hearty steak or beef casserole.

Ageing Potential: A wine to be enjoyed 1-5 years from the year of vintage.
